

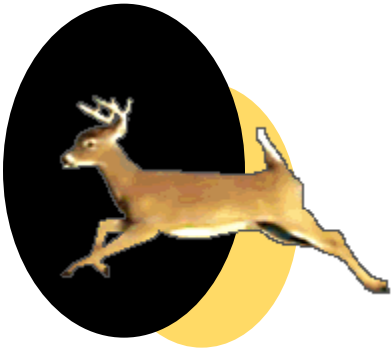

About the Hunt

The AA Winter Hunt was started in 2000 as a fundraiser for Autauga Academy. Friends and supporters of the school have donated the use of approximately 40,000 acres of privately owned, prime hunting land in Autauga County for the hunt.

Directions

From Birmingham take I-65 South to Prattville. From Montgomery take I-65 North to exit #179. Go West to Hwy 14 to Autaugaville. Proceed 3.5 miles to County Road 45 North. Turn right and continue 0.2 miles to camp house.

Registration

Forms and 1/2 of the payment must be received within ten days of telephone booking, with the full balance due by the first day of your hunt. No refunds will be granted after this date. Confirmation emails will be sent following booking.

A separate registration form is required for each hunter. Hunters wishing to hunt on certain dates with friends should indicate the names of others in their party on the registration form. Registration forms may be copied. E-mail and telephone bookings are available.

Hunting Package

First Weekend—Three-Day Hunt: The three-day hunt begins at noon on Thursday, Jan. 14th, and goes through noon on Sunday, Jan. 17th.

Second Weekend—Three-Day Hunt: The three-day hunt begins at noon on Thursday, Jan. 21st, and goes through noon on Sunday, Jan. 24th.

The cost of the hunt is \$350 per day, per person.

Land Description

All hunting will take place on privately owned property in Autauga County, Alabama. Tree stands overlook clear cut land, food plots, hardwood

bottoms, corn and soybean fields. Some lands are restricted as to the deer kills, while some lands are not.

Requirements

An Alabama State Hunting License is required. A non-resident license, good for ten days, is available Walmart in Prattville or online. See our website at www.aawinterhunt.com for the link to purchase a license. A Hunter's Education Certificate is required for all hunters born after August 1st, 1977, after their 16th birthday. Hunter orange must be worn during the hunt. There will be a safety meeting before the hunt.

What to Bring

Each hunter should bring a rifle or a bow and ammo (no shotguns). Each hunter will also need a flashlight, warm clothes, a rain suit, waterproof boots, and a large cooler.

Deer Limits

Each hunter will be allowed to take two deer per day— one antlered buck and one doe or two does. Only three bucks can be taken for the year with at least one having no less than four points on one side. There is no yearly limit on does.

Processing

Cleaning and quartering of the deer is included in the package price. A local processor is available if you choose complete processing at your expense.

Lodging

Lodging is available at the AA Winter Hunt Camp House and River Houses. Camp House lodging is available on a first come, first serve basis. Book early and have a Camp House Room reserved.
